SOUTHWESTERN BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY'S REVISED MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF CHANGES TO THE MISSOURI 271 AGREEMENT

COMES NOW Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a Southwestern Bell Telephone Company ("SWBT"), and for its Revised Motion for Approval of Changes to the Missouri 271 Interconnection Agreement ("M2A") states as follows:

- 1. The Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued its
 Report and Order in this case on February 28, 2002 ("Report and Order") with an
 effective date of March 30, 2002. The Commission issued its Order Denying Rehearing
 and Granting Clarification ("Order Denying Rehearing") on June 4, 2002. As a result of
 the Report and Order, SWBT filed its initial Motion for Approval of Changes to the
 Missouri 271 Interconnection Agreement on July 11, 2002.
- 2. Several parties filed in response to SWBT's initial Motion. Staff's Response to Southwestern Bell Telephone Company's Motion for Approval of Changes to the Missouri 271 Interconnection Agreement was filed on July 17, 2002 and stated Staff's view that the proposed modifications comported with the Commission's Orders. XO Missouri, Inc., MCImetro Access Transmission Services, L.L.C., Brooks Fiber Communications of Missouri, Inc. and MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc. filed a



Response to Southwestern Bell Telephone Company's Motion for Approval of Changes to the M2A on July 18, 2002. ("XO's Response") IP Communications of the Southwest filed its Response to the Motion for Approval of Changes to the Missouri 271 Interconnection Agreement of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company on July 22, 2002. ("IP's Response") XO's Response and IP's Response sought additional changes/clarifications to the revisions to the M2A.

- 3. As a result of discussions among these parties, agreement has been reached concerning the appropriate language to revise M2A Attachment 25: xDSL and the Optional Line Sharing Amendment to Attachment 25 concerning the Interim Appendix HFPL. Attached as Exhibit 1 are the revised Attachment 25: xDSL and Optional Line Sharing Amendment. Attached as Exhibit 2 is the redlined versions of those documents, displaying the proposed changes from the previously approved versions.
- 4. While SWBT is revising the M2A in compliance with the Commission's Report and Order, SWBT wishes to make clear that it does not waive, but expressly reserves all rights, remedies and arguments it may have with respect to the Report and Order and the rates, terms and conditions set forth in Attachment 25: xDSL and the Optional Line Sharing Amendment to the M2A. SWBT incorporates by reference herein its reservation of rights as set forth in paragraph 3 of its initial Motion for Approval of Changes to the Missouri 271 Interconnection Agreement.

WHEREFORE, for all the foregoing reasons, SWBT respectfully requests the Commission to approve its Revised Motion for Approval of Changes to the Missouri 271 Interconnection Agreement.
