4	for approval to transfer certain assets to Lightyear
5	Communications, Inc.
6	My name is Nancy Dippell. I'm the judge
7	assigned on this matter, and we come here today for a
8	prehearing conference which was rescheduled, and I
9	understand, perhaps, the parties have already gotten
10	things worked out, but I'll let you go ahead and make
11	entries of appearance and then you can tell me the
12	status.
13	Mr. Fischer, do you want to begin?
14	MR. FISCHER: Yes. Let the record reflect the

18	The Free Network LLC and Lightyear Communications, Inc.
