MOTION TO DISMISS

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and moves the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) to dismiss the application to transfer assets and states as follows:

1. On April 28, 2010, Comtel Telcom Assets LP (“Comtel”) and Matrix Telecom, Inc.(“Matrix”) asked the Commission to approve a transfer of certain assets from Comtel to Matrix. The Applicants state that they make their application pursuant to §392.300 RSMo 2000.
2. Both Comtel and Matrix are alternative local exchange telecommunications companies, as well as interexchange telecommunications companies.
3. Effective August 28, 2008, §392.420 RSMo Supp. 2009 provides that “for all existing alternative local exchange telecommunications companies, the commission shall waive...the application and enforcement of ...section ...392.300...”
4. Approval or denial of the Application would constitute “application and enforcement” of §392.300 RSMo 2000. Therefore, the Commission should dismiss the Application, without granting or denying the relief requested in it, and inform the applicants that the requirement to obtain Commission approval for the transfer of assets, to the extent it ever applied to them, no longer applies.

WHEREFORE, the Staff respectfully moves the Commission dismiss the Application for Transfer of Certain Assets and Customer Base.
