ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On June 9, 2006, VCI Company ("VCI") filed its petition seeking designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier. On June 13, 2006, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("AT&T") submitted its Application to Intervene pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075. On June 15, the Staff of the Commission was directed to respond to AT&T's application.

On June 22, Staff filed its response to AT&T's application to intervene, and although Staff stated that AT&T was not in strict compliance with 4 CSR 240-2.075(2) for having not stated what position it will take in VCI's application, Staff concluded that it did not oppose AT&T's intervention. No other party has sought to oppose AT&T's motion to intervene within the ten-day period allowed in 4 CSR 240-2.080(15). Consequently, the Commission will grant AT&T's motion to intervene.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri's Application for Intervention is granted.

2. This order shall become effective on June 26, 2006.
