**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, DIRECTING FILING, AND
ESTABLISHING TIME FOR FILING REQUESTS TO INTERVENE**

This order directs notice of the case to be sent to all competitive local exchange carriers and incumbent local exchange carriers certificated to operate in the state of Missouri. The order also directs supplemental pleadings and establishes dates for filing requests to intervene.

On June 9, 2006, VCI Company (“VCI”) filed its petition seeking designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier. VCI seeks this designation pursuant to Sections 214(e)(2) and (e)(6) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, Sections 54.101 through 54.207 of the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”), and 4 CSR 240-3.570.

Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(K) and (L) state:

(1) All applications shall comply with the requirements of these rules and shall include the following information:

(K) A statement indicating whether the applicant has any pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involve customer service or rates, which action, judgment or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of the application;

(L) A statement that no annual report or assessment fees are overdue.

VCI's application did not comply with the parts of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1) cited above in that it did not include the required statements. VCI will be required to file a supplemental pleading curing these defects.

The Commission finds that proper persons should be allowed 30 days from the issuance of this order to file a request for intervention or a motion for hearing. The Commission will direct its Data Center to send a copy of this order to each competitive local exchange carrier and incumbent local exchange carrier certificated to operate in Missouri.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. VCI Company shall file, no later than July 12, 2006, a supplemental pleading which shall include a statement indicating whether it has any pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involve customer service or rates, which action, judgment or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of this application.

2. VCI Company shall file, no later than July 12, 2006, a supplemental pleading which shall include a statement indicating that no annual report or assessment fees are overdue.

3. The Data Center shall send a copy of this order to each competitive local exchange carrier and incumbent local exchange carrier certificated to operate in Missouri.
