



5 **Q. What is your name and business address?**

6 A. My name is Tom Anvin, and my address is 225 W Randolph, Chicago IL, 60606
7

8 **Q. By whom are you employed and in what position?**

9 A. I am employed by Ameritech Corporate. My title is Associate Director of
10 Competitive Intelligence. I am responsible for monitoring the competitive
11 environments in which SBC Communications Inc. (SBC) operates and identifying
12 and communicating new and changing competitive environments affecting SBC.
13

14 **Q. What is your relevant employment and educational background?**

15 A. Please see Schedule 1 for my employment and educational background.
16

17 **Q. Have you previously testified before the Missouri Public Service Commission
18 (Commission)?**

19 A. No.
20

21 **Q. What is the purpose of your testimony?**

22 A. I am testifying on behalf of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) and
23 the purpose of my testimony is to:
24

- 1 • Describe in general the competitive environment of the local
- 2 telecommunications industry, and the various alternative ways new
- 3 competitors enter the market.
- 4 • Explain that SWBT's service is by no means the only option in providing
- 5 telecommunications services and that other service providers are offering
- 6 functionally equivalent telephony services through a variety of technologies.
- 7 • Explain that as technology advances and services converge, end users are not
- 8 concerned with how the service is delivered but rather ease of use, quality of
- 9 service delivered and availability of services.

10

11 Q. **Please highlight some of the different methods new market entrants are using**
12 **to compete in the local telephony business.**

13 A. The local telephony market is a competitive business where there are many
14 alternative providers offering telecommunications services using a variety of
15 technologies. Examples include competitors building their own networks,
16 resellers, unbundled network element (UNE) based providers, and alternative
17 methods of non-land line service, such as wireless telephony, satellite services,
18 and fixed wireless technologies. Even cable TV providers are now offering voice
19 services over their hybrid fiber coax networks. Also, new non-telephone service
20 providers are having a great impact on the communications industry. These
21 alternate providers offer customers the choice of voice services, such as Internet
22 telephony, and non-voice services, such as email and instant messaging. The
23 growing number of alternative providers is clearly an indication of how

1 consumers are now able and prefer to communicate over a greater variety of
2 platforms.

3

4 **Q. Please provide more detail on these different market approaches.**

5 A. Facilities-based providers can offer a full suite of communications services and
6 bundles either through building their own networks or through UNEs they lease
7 from SWBT. Service providers choosing to build their own network usually build
8 very high capacity, state of the art networks. UNE providers have the advantage
9 that they can pick and choose whatever network elements they need to serve a
10 particular customer. This allows these providers to create a high quality network
11 at a much lower capital investment level. Given that UNE providers use network
12 elements already in place, they can also expand their service areas very quickly.
13 They also have the option to develop their own systems to provide new highly
14 profitable advanced calling features, such as caller ID, or three way calling.

15

16 Resellers purchase SWBT's services on a wholesale basis at a discount and then
17 provide the service to their end users. These providers offer their customers the
18 same services as SWBT and can enter the market without the burden of network
19 investment.

20

21 As wireless service grows in popularity, more and more people are displacing
22 their usage away from traditional landline networks and towards these wireless
23 services. Wireless service providers are now offering packages with a large

1 number of included minutes including local and long distance. According to a
2 recent report by the FCC, 20 million wireless subscribers have "free" long
3 distance. (FCC's Sixth Annual Report on the state of competition in the wireless
4 Marketplace). Wireless plans also provide free calling to a number of users, or
5 sharing a block of minutes between phones. These types of plans are increasingly
6 making wireless service an attractive alternative to landline local service.

7

8 Fixed wireless providers use mostly microwave technologies to offer residential
9 and business users high-grade voice quality and high bandwidth network
10 connectivity. These providers maintain an advantage of quick installation time
11 and extensive coverage using a low cost solution. With the high bandwidth
12 available through these systems, service providers are heavily targeting business
13 users to provide service as a replacement to high-speed access trunks as well as
14 voice service. Further, MCI Worldcom and Sprint have bought large amounts of
15 bandwidth to provide these services and are now rolling out total communications
16 solutions utilizing this technology to small business and residential users.

17

18 Cable telephony is another technology which is being used to provide local phone
19 services. Cable providers are now offering a wider range of products and services
20 including traditional telephone service over their cable network. AT&T, the
21 largest cable TV provider in the nation, and other cable providers have expended
22 considerable effort to enhance their networks to allow them to bundle video and
23 data services with new voice offerings. The benefit of these bundled services is

1 the high bandwidth network and ability to offer a wider range of services. Cable
2 companies are positioning themselves to be a one-stop shop for a household's
3 entire entertainment and communications needs. AT&T recently disclosed that it
4 had signed up 500,000 cable TV subscribers to its telephone service by the end of
5 2000¹. According to the National Cable Television Association, at least nine of
6 the nation's largest multiple system operators (MSOs) now offer residential and/or
7 commercial phone service in more than 45 markets, serving more than one
8 million customers. In Schedule 2, I show the growth in telephone service
9 subscribers served by these MSOs.

10
11 Internet Telephony is also making its mark in the telecommunications industry.
12 Internet Telephony is a technology which allows providers to route telephone
13 calls over the Internet. Providers such as Net2Phone and Dialpad.com offer voice
14 communications using Internet technology. The quality and reliability of this
15 technology is improving rapidly, as evidenced by the number of users.
16 Dialpad.com has 9 million users and routes approximately 800,000 calls per day.
17 Also maturing are other packetized solutions that can transmit voice services,
18 such as pure Voice over IP (VoIP) and Voice over broadband connections such as
19 DSL or Cable Modems (Voice over Broadband (VoB)). The Yankee Group has
20 estimated that by 2005 there will be well over 1.6 million VoB connections in the
21 U.S. With these newer services being able to support more than one voice grade
22 connection in addition to high speed data services, they are providing a

1 competitive threat to primary access lines and additional lines used for additional
2 voice service or for dial up access to the internet.

3

4 Finally, more communication is being done by means of non-voice services, such
5 as email, Instant messaging, and e-commerce. As more and more business is
6 conducted on the Internet or over some other form of e-commerce (electronic
7 means), it greatly reduces the need for phone conversations related to such
8 processes as order taking, shipping arrangements, and delivery status reporting.

9 Email has become the primary means for official communication in the work
10 place. Email allows for convenient distribution of messages and documents to a
11 large number of recipients. Instant messaging (IM) is also displacing phone calls
12 by emerging as a "chat" tool in the residential market and a quick and efficient
13 communications device in the business market that enables work group members
14 to stay in touch in real time. About 61 million people, or roughly half the online
15 population, use instant messaging, according to research firm Jupiter Media
16 Metrix. According to Jupiter Media Metrix, the number of IM users could grow
17 to 151 million by 2003².

18

19 **Q. Please expand on how wireless service has become a comparable alternative
20 to the traditional services offered by SWBT.**

21 A. Wireless carriers are now serving 109 million subscribers throughout the nation
22 (1.8 million in MO) and subscribership has been growing by about 20% per year.
23 (Schedule 3) According to a recent Yankee Group Study, 16.5% of all voice

1 traffic is now transmitted over wireless networks and 3% of wireless users do not
2 have a landline telephone. A much greater percentage of customers are using
3 their wireless phones for calls that previously would have been made on their
4 landline telephone. These numbers are echoed in the FCC's Sixth Annual Report
5 on the state of competition in the wireless marketplace, which corroborates the
6 3% total displacement figure. According to the FCC report, 12% of respondents
7 in the FCC study purchased a mobile phone instead of an additional landline.

8 (Schedule 4) FCC chairman Michael Powell recently acknowledged the
9 substitutability of wireless service for landline voice service when he stated:
10 "And I will tell you, we underestimate the value of wireless, as a substitute for
11 local services. I make many calls on my wireless phone, sitting in the driveway of
12 my house, the front yard while I'm gardening, and I haven't picked up the phone
13 in a hotel in five years, because I use my wireless phone. That's all coming out of
14 what would have been a traditional call by a local company or an incumbent."

15 (FORRESTER RESEARCH TELECOM FORUM, Q & A with Chairman Powell
16 May 21, 2001). As the capabilities of new wireless phones and other wireless
17 devices expand and with the arrival of 3rd Generation wireless systems, (which
18 among other things will allow high speed access to data via a wireless phone), we
19 are likely to see these numbers accelerate at even faster rates. Additionally,
20 wireless services will become even more reliable and wireless providers will be
21 able to offer location-based services.

1 **Q. Can you please explain other forms of communication that people use instead
2 of traditional telephone service?**

3 A. Technology has provided additional means of communication that serve as a
4 substitute for SWBT's telecommunications services. Communications in general
5 is changing to include more alternatives to the telephone, such as email and
6 messaging. Information Technology research firm IDC has estimated that there
7 are more than 35 BILLION emails sent each day. Up until a few years ago, many
8 of these messages would likely have been telephone conversations. Not only are
9 we communicating by different means but also new integrated platforms are
10 starting to offer more advanced voice services. AOL and Microsoft have voice
11 applications in their software and plan to offer traditional voice service via their
12 computer software packages. Microsoft recently announced that its upcoming
13 Windows XP operating system will include not only Voice and Instant message
14 capabilities but also Video Conferencing and collaboration on shared files and
15 applications. In addition, this new technology will be able to support a number of
16 Vertical features such as caller ID and voice mail. Having a market leader and
17 giant like Microsoft moving towards the vision of pulling communications away
18 from traditional landline telephone service is indication that the "future" of
19 telecommunications is here today. A company with Microsoft's talent and
20 financial resources would only be expected to pursue strategies that are likely to
21 be very successful. Furthermore, the fact that Microsoft is already advertising its
22 MSN voice services on television (Schedule 5) is a reflection of where
23 communications is going; it is evident that communications is moving to an all-

1 integrated platform providing a wider range of advanced services from which
2 customers can choose.

3

4 **Q. Does the Commission regulate the alternatives that you have described?**

5 A. Not to a significant degree. While the Commission does have regulatory
6 authority over some of the alternatives such as CLECs and Interexchange Carriers
7 (IXCs), the Commission does not regulate alternative technologies such as
8 wireless services, cable TV providers, satellite-based services, and Internet-
9 enabled communication including Internet telephony, email, instant messaging
10 and e-commerce applications.

11

12 **Q. Does the Commission typically regulate CLECs' and IXCs' prices?**

13 A. No. CLECs and IXCs have very broad pricing flexibility.

14

15 **Q. Do CLECs and IXCs have to become certificated to provide
16 telecommunications services in Missouri?**

17

18 A. Yes. There are over 145 CLECs certificated to provide local services in Missouri
19 and over 600 IXCs certificated to provide interexchange services in Missouri.
20 Lists of such CLECs and IXCs are attached as Schedules 6 and 7.

21

22 **Q. Are CLECs and IXCs required to file tariffs with the Commission?**

1 A. Yes. CLECs and IXCs are required to file tariffs with the Commission describing
2 the services they provide including the terms, conditions and prices for those
3 services.

4

5 Q. **Are there a significant number of CLECs who have approved tariffs to
6 provide service throughout SWBT's exchanges in Missouri?**

7 A. Yes. In Schedule 8, I have identified by exchange, the number of CLECs that
8 have tariffs indicating they provide service in that exchange. Schedule 9 provides
9 a map summarizing the number of CLEC tariffs by exchange. These Schedules
10 reflect that there is at least 52 CLECs in every SWBT exchange whose tariffs
11 indicate they are authorized to provide service in those exchanges. Schedule 10
12 provides some sample tariffs filed by a few CLECs. Other SWBT witnesses
13 reference particular sections of these tariffs to demonstrate that CLECs provide
14 services that are substitutable or functionally equivalent to SWBT's services at
15 reasonably comparable rates, terms and conditions.

16

17 Q. **What are the main points the Commission should understand from your
18 testimony?**

19 A. The Commission should understand the broad picture of the rapidly changing
20 nature of communications, including:
21 • Recognizing the various alternatives to traditional landline competition
22 evidenced by a growing number of service providers and emerging services,
23 such as Wireless and Internet-based communication.

- Realizing from personal and work experience that the means of communications are evolving and the need to stay competitive is now greater than ever. Customers in SWBT's territory have had many choices for years in selecting their service provider ranging from established companies using similar technologies (e.g., CLECs, IXCs) to entrants using a wider range of technologies (e.g., wireless providers).
- Understanding that email and other non-voice services are often replacing "telephone calls," and can do so at a significantly lower price to the consumer. These technologies, including instant messaging, are becoming increasingly popular.
- Understanding that the traditional telephone market is changing very rapidly and cannot be measured by the same metrics as only a few years ago. As technologies converge and become transparent, it is critical that SWBT have the freedom to compete on a level playing field. Open competition in a market place where all providers are on equal footing will lead to new innovation and more customer choice.

Q. Does this conclude your testimony?

A. Yes, it does.





(b) The subscriber assumes all risks for damages arising out of mistakes, omissions, interruptions, delays, errors, or defects in transmission or from failure or defects in equipment and facilities furnished by Carrier occurring in the course of providing service.

4. DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

Carrier provides a dial-up interexchange service which is available for subscriber use twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week. Access to the service is obtained by dialing a seven (7) digit access number or an 800 inward WATS number. Either of these numbers will produce a dial tone. The subscriber then dials 1 plus the area code and the local number. This will cause a "stutter dial tone." The subscriber then enters his authorization number and the call is completed. The subscriber uses a connection through the local exchange network to shared off-net access lines to originate calls anywhere within the State of Missouri to any other point within the State. Charges are based on the distance and duration of the call as well as the time of day and day of the week when the call is placed.

A Remote 800 number access is provided as a customer convenience. The fee on calls coming into and terminating in the Cape, Sikeston, Perryville and Anna, Illinois local exchanges on the 800 number will be charged at a day rate of fifty cents (\$.50) per minute and an evening rate after 5:00 p.m. of thirty cents (\$.30) per minute. Calls coming into these local exchanges but terminating in an area other than Cape, Sikeston, Perryville and Anna, Illinois, areas on the 800 number will be charged at a day rate of fifty cents (\$.50) per minute and an evening rate of thirty cents (\$.30) per minute PLUS the LDD interLATA or LDD intraLATA scheduled tariff rates for the time that the call was made. The additional 800 charge will be identified on the subscriber's statement as a REMOTE 800 Service Charge.

A direct dial 1 plus equal access service is also provided.
