1	PROCEEDINGS
2	JUDGE WOODRUFF: We're here today for a
3	prehearing conference in Case No. WA-2002-65. It's
4	In the Matter of the Application of Environmental
5	Utilities, L.L.C., for Permission, Approval, and a
6	Certificate of Convenience and Necessity
7	Authorizing it to Construct, Install, Own, Operate,
8	Control, Manage and Maintain a Water System for the
9	Public Located in Unincorporated Portions of
10	Camden County, Missouri, specifically the Golden
11	Glade Subdivision.
12	And we'll begin today by taking entries of
13	appearance beginning with Environmental Utilities.
14	MR. WILLIAMS: Gregory Williams,
15	Highway 5, Lake Road 533, P.O. Box 431, Sunrise
16	Beach, Missouri 65079, on behalf of Environmental
17	Utilities, L.L.C.
18	JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you.
19	And for Staff?
20	MS. KIZITO: Good morning, your Honor.
21	Victoria Kizito, appearing for Staff of the Public
22	Service Commission. Also present today is Jim
23	Merciel and Martin Hummel and Jim Russo, Staff of
24	the Water Sewer Department and Accounting

- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you.
- 2 For Public Counsel?
- 3 MS. O'NEILL: Good morning. Ruth O'Neill
- 4 for the Office of the Public Counsel, P.O. Box
- 5 7800, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.
- 5 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you very much.
- 7 I believe that's all the parties. The
- 8 primary reason we're here today, of course, is to
- 9 have you work together on submitting a proposed
- 10 procedural schedule. And by previous order, that
- 11 was made due one week from today on
- 12 September 26th.
- 13 Environmental Utilities also filed a
- 14 motion asking the Commission to deny the request
- for a hearing. I'm not going to make a ruling on
- 16 that today. The Commission will have to do that at
- 17 an agenda. But for purposes of today's proceeding,
- 18 go ahead and assume that they will go ahead and
- 19 prepare the procedural schedule. We'll deal with
- 20 the other matters later.
- 21 Let me go ahead and ask at this point,
- 22 I'll ask Public Counsel first, do you know what
- issues will be involved in this case?
- MR. O'NEILL: Your Honor, I'm not sure.
- 25 We were not served with the application until after

- 1 the order directing filing was sent out. I think
- 2 we got it on the 21st or 22nd -- 23rd actually is
- 3 when we received the application. I'm not going to
- 4 say categorically that I haven't received the
- 5 motion -- or asking that the motion for hearing be
- 6 denied, because it may be in my office, and I just
- 7 haven't seen it when that was filed.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: It was termed as a
- 9 response to your request.
- 10 MS. O'NEILL: I don't recall seeing it
- 11 yet. That doesn't mean it's not upstairs. I also
- haven't received and we haven't received, the
- 13 supplemental filing that was due September 5th from
- 14 the order directing the filing. I don't know if I
- 15 didn't get on the service list or --
- MR. WILLIAMS: I do have a new secretary.
- 17 I won't swear that that didn't happen.
- MS. O'NEILL: And it is possible that that
- 19 is -- you know, the mail has been a little bit odd
- 20 lately, so . . .
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Just so the record is
- 22 clear, Mr. Williams has handed you a couple of
- 23 documents. I assume those are the documents she
- 24 was talking about?
- MR. WILLIAMS: Those are copies of it,

- 1 that's correct.
- MS. O'NEILL: I don't have this packet of
- documents, so I appreciate getting those. I'm not
- 4 really sure at this point what the whole scope of
- 5 what the issues may be in this case, but we may be
- 6 able to work towards settlement of these issues and
- 7 come to some kind of stipulation and agreement.
- 8 I'm certainly willing to work towards that.
- 9 However, we didn't feel that we had enough
- 10 information just based on the application to sit
- 11 back and let the Commission determine whether a
- 12 hearing was necessary.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you.
- 14 And does Staff have a position on this
- 15 application yet?
- MS. KIZITO: Your Honor, the Staff has a
- 17 couple of issues that it hopes it can work out with
- 18 counsel for Environmental Utilities, but at this
- 19 time also, though, we are not sure if a hearing
- 20 will be necessary as we hope the issues can be
- 21 worked out.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. And, of course,
- 23 that can be done today also hopefully.
- Mr. Williams, anything that you want to
- 25 bring up?

1	MR. WILLIAMS: No. I think our motion is
2	before the Commission, and we'll stand on that at
3	this point in time.
4	JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right. Well, with
5	that then we will conclude the on-the-record
6	portion of the prehearing conference, and I'll
7	leave you to your discussions. Thank you very
8	much.
9	WHEREUPON, the on-the-record portion of
10	the prehearing conference was concluded.
