ORDER APPROVING INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

Issue Date: December 9, 2021 Effective Date: January 8, 2022

This order approves a negotiated Interconnection Agreement between the parties filed by CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC d/b/a CenturyLink and Spectra Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyLink.

On October 12, 2021, CenturyLink filed an application with the Commission for approval of a negotiated Interconnection Agreement with Time Warner Cable Information Services (Missouri), LLC d/b/a Time Warner Cable under the provisions of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. That initial application was deficient in that it did not comply with the 60-day notice requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017. After the Commission issued notice of that deficiency, CenturyLink filed an amended application on October 28, 2021. CenturyLink is certificated with the Commission as an incumbent local exchange carrier. Time Warner Cable is certificated with the Commission as a competitive local exchange and an interexchange carrier.

Although Time Warner Cable is a party to the Agreement, it did not join in the application. On November 3, 2021, the Commission issued an order making Time Warner

Cable a party in this case and directing any party wishing to request a hearing to do so no later than November 18, 2021. No requests for hearing were filed.

Under Section 252(e) of the Act, any Interconnection Agreement adopted by negotiation must be submitted to the Commission for approval. The Commission may reject an Agreement if it finds that the Agreement is discriminatory or that it is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

On December 3, 2021, the Staff of the Commission filed a recommendation. Staff recommends that the Agreement be approved and notes that the Agreement meets the limited requirements of the Act in that it is not discriminatory toward nonparties and is not against the public interest.

The Commission has considered the application, the supporting documentation, and Staff's recommendation. Based upon that review, the Commission finds that the Agreement meets the requirements of the Act in that it does not discriminate against a nonparty carrier and implementation of the Agreement is not inconsistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

The application represents that the applicant has not had contact with the office of the Commission about any substantive issue connected to the filing within 60 days before filing the application. On the basis of that representation, for good cause shown, the Commission will waive application of the pre-filing notice requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1).

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Interconnection Agreement between CenturyLink and Time Warner Cable, filed on October 12, 2021, is approved.
