ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO RESPOND TO PUBLIC COUNSEL'S MOTION TO SUSPEND TARIFF

On March 14, 2012, MoKan Dial, Inc. filed tariff sheets that would change its approved rates for local telephone service. The Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion on March 16, asking the Commission to suspend that tariff to allow time to investigate whether the revised rates proposed by MoKan Dial will be just and reasonable. On March 19, the Commission issued an order that allowed interested parties until March 26 to respond to Public Counsel's motion.

Subsequently, MoKan Dial filed a motion asking the Commission to extend the time allowed for responding to Public Counsel's motion to suspend until March 30. MoKan Dial's request is reasonable and the Commission will grant the requested extension.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Any party that wishes to respond to the Office of the Public Counsel's Objection and Motion to Suspend shall do so no later than March 30, 2012.
 - 2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
