## TRANSOURCE MISSOURI'S VERIFIED RESPONSE TO STAFF'S MEMORANDUM RECOMMENDATION

**COMES NOW**, Transource Missouri LLC, by and through counsel, provides the following verified response pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080 to "Staff's Memorandum Recommendation" ("Recommendation"):

- 1. On August 25, 2016 the Commission Ordered Staff to file a recommendation regarding Transource Missouri's application for a certificate of convenience and necessity for a Switch Station to interconnect the Osborn Wind Energy Center with the Applicant's Sibley-Nebraska City transmission line.
- 2. On September 20, 2016 Staff filed its Recommendation. In the Recommendation Staff agrees that "Transource Missouri meets the criteria that the Commission has used in the recent past for granting a CCN for the construction of electric plant." Recommendation at 14.
- 3. The Recommendation provides that "as a condition of granting Transource Missouri a CCN in this proceeding, Transource Missouri should direct Transource Missouri to file on an annual basis its current annual FERC FORM 1 with this Commission at the same time it makes its annual filing with the FERC and this filing be deemed to be in lieu of the filing

required by 4 CSR 240-3.164." Recommendation at 15. Transource Missouri commits to file the FERC FORM 1 on an annual basis at the same time it makes such filing with the FERC.

- 4. The Recommendation also provides, "[T]he Staff proposes that as a condition of granting Transource Missouri a CCN, Transource Missouri should agree to file with the Commission, as soon as they are available, the final engineering deliverables, including design packages, procurement delivery schedules, construction contract bid technical specifications." Recommendation at 16. Transource Missouri will provide these deliverables to the Commission as soon as they are available to Transource Missouri.
- 5. As Staff recommends approval of the CCN with conditions acceptable to Transource Missouri, Transource Missouri will not respond to either Section 1 of the Recommendation or Paragraph 26 of the Recommendation regarding the requirements of 4 CSR 240-3.105(1)(B)(2). Transource Missouri's acceptance of the recommended conditions provided by Staff should not be deemed agreement, acquiescence, or waiver of any legal position held by Transource Missouri in this case or any future case.

WHEREFORE, Transource Missouri requests the Commission approve Transource Missouri's Application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity Authorizing it to Own, Operate, and Maintain a Switchyard Necessary for the Interconnection of the Osborn Wind Energy Center with the Sibley-Nebraska City Electric Transmission Project.
