STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), through the undersigned counsel, and files this *Staff Recommendation* with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) respectfully stating the following:

Procedural History

- 1. On May 14, 2009, Birch Telecom of Missouri, Inc d/b/a Birch Communications (Birch), and Now Communications, Inc., known in Missouri as Now Communications, Inc., d/b/a Cleartel Communications (NOW), all known collectively herein as the Applicants, filed a joint *Application For Authority To Transfer Assets (Joint Application)*. The Applicants have entered into an Asset Purchase Agreement (Agreement) to sell, assign, transfer, convey and deliver certain assets to Birch, including NOW's approximately 200 Missouri prepaid local service customers.
- 2. The *Joint Application* states Birch will also assume all managerial, technical, and financial responsibilities in connection with the operation of the retail prepaid local assets in order to provide telecommunications services to the Missouri customers.
- 3. Further, the *Joint Application* states notice will to be sent to the affected customers on or after June 1, 2009.

4. On May 18, 2009, the Commission issued its *Order Directing Filing*, by which Staff was directed to file a recommendation on or before June 1, 2009, and the Applicants were directed to supplement their application. On May 19, 2009, the Applicants supplemented their application with Exhibit E, detailing certain assets to be transferred by the Agreement.

Staff Recommendation

- 5. Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.060 and 240-3.520, telecommunications companies transferring assets are to file with the Commission a "....brief description of the property involved in the transaction, including any franchises, permits, operating rights or certificates of convenience and necessity", and "a copy of the contract or agreement of sale."
- 6. In this instance, the Applicants have complied with the Commission's rules, and Staff believes this transaction is not detrimental to the public interest. Staff's *Memorandum* is attached as Appendix A.
- 7. Both Applicants request no certificate of service authority granted by the Commission be cancelled with this *Joint Application*.
- 8. Neither Applicant is deficient in the Commission's annual report filing requirements, or remittances of annual assessment, Universal Service Fund or Relay Missouri charges.

WHEREFORE, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission recommends the Commission grant the transfer of asset authority requested in the *Joint Application*, with Birch Telecom of Missouri, Inc., d/b/a Birch Communications to file updated tariff sheets containing the charges and customer services being transferred in this merger.
