NOTICE OF DEFICIENCY

Issue Date: February 14, 2008

On February 11, 2008, McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc. ("McLeod")

filed letters notifying the Missouri Public Service Commission of a corporate name change.

The purpose of the change is evidently to enable McLeod to provide business

telecommunications services in Missouri under the fictitious name "PAETEC Business

Services." Attached to the letters are revised tariff sheets reflecting the name change and

making certain other modifications.²

The letters and attachments do not substantially comply with Commission Rules 4

CSR 240-2.060(5), 4 CSR 240-3.020(1), and 4 CSR 240-3.545, which govern the contents

of applications for corporate name changes and setting forth filing requirements for

telecommunications company tariffs.³ If McLeod does not correct these deficiencies by

Thursday, February 21, 2008, the tariffs will be rejected and this case will be dismissed

without further notice.

This would result in the following new corporate name: McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc. d/b/a PAETEC Business Services.

Both tariffs, which do not include adoption notices, have a proposed effective date of March 12, 2008.

For example, they do not include any evidence that McLeod has registered the fictitious name with the Missouri Secretary of State, as required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(5)(B).
