#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

- 1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) approve Bluestar Communications, Inc.'s adoption of the GTE Midwest and GTE Arkansas (collectively, "GTE") and AT&T Communications (AT&T) Interconnection, Resale and Unbundling Agreement (Agreement) pursuant to § 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (Act).
- 2. The Commission approved the GTE/AT&T Agreement in Case No. TO-97-63. In the Commission's July 22, 1998 Order, the Commission stated that the Agreement meets the standards set forth in Section 252(e) of the Act in that it does not appear to discriminate against telecommunications carriers not party to the Agreement and does not appear to be against the public interest, convenience, or necessity.
- 3. Therefore, Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) grant approval of the adoption of the Agreement pursuant to the Act. In addition,

the Staff recommends that the Commission direct the Parties to file any modifications or amendments to the Agreement with the Commission for approval.
