On July 12, 2005, USCOC of Greater Missouri, LLC d/b/a U.S. Cellular filed the direct testimony of Kevin Lowell. However, Lowell's affidavit affirming the truth and accuracy of his testimony, which was attached to that testimony, was not signed. On July 13, U.S. Cellular filed a motion asking for leave to file Lowell's signed affidavit out of time. The signed affidavit was attached to the motion.

4 CSR 240-2.080(15) provides that parties are allowed not more than ten days in which to respond to a pleading unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. More than ten days have passed since U.S. Cellular filed its motion and no responses have been filed. Therefore, the Commission will presume that the motion is unopposed.

U.S. Cellular's motion is reasonable and is not opposed by any party. It will be granted.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That USCOC of Greater Missouri, LLC d/b/a U.S. Cellular's Motion for Leave to File Affidavit of Kevin Lowell Out of Time is granted.

2. That this order shall become effective on July 25, 2005.
