On August 10, 2005, the Commission adopted the procedural schedule proposed by the parties. On September 8, 2005, Northwest Missouri Cellular Limited Partnership requested a 30-day extension of the time for the filing of Direct Testimony. On that same date, Grand River Mutual Telephone Corporation and Holway Telephone Company filed a response in which they stated that they had no objection to the extension, so long as the entire procedural schedule was extended by 30 days. No further responses were received.

On October 11, 2005, Northwest Missouri Cellular Limited Partnership requested an indefinite suspension of the procedural schedule due to the serious illness of its lead witness. The Commission has reviewed the motion for suspension and determines that the extension shall be granted.

2. That the entire procedural schedule is suspended indefinitely.

3. That Northwest Missouri Cellular Limited Partnership shall file a report no

later than January 11, 2006, indicating the status of this case.
