ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, ESTABLISHING TIME FOR FILING REQUEST TO INTERVENE, AND ESTABLISHING TIME FOR FILING RECOMMENDATION

This order directs that notice be sent to all certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications companies in the state of Missouri and to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator. The order also establishes dates for the filing of requests to intervene and for the filing of recommendations.

On February 24, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri filed an application under 47 C.F.R. 52.15(g)(3)(iv) requesting that the Commission overturn a decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator. This application concerns the assignment of four 10,000 blocks to implement the agreement filed in Commission Case No. TO-2005-0141 concerning expansion of the Metropolitan Calling Area Plan to include the Exchange of Washington, Union, Wright City, St. Clair, Marthasville, Beaufort, Foley and Warrenton. AT&T requests that the Commission act on this application within ten days.

The Commission finds that proper persons should be allowed to file a request for intervention or a motion for hearing. The Commission will direct its Data Center to send a copy of this order to each certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications company in Missouri. Additionally, the Data Center shall send a copy of this order to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, NeuStar, Inc.

The Commission will also direct its Staff to file a recommendation and establish a date by which any other party wishing to respond must do so.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Data Center shall send a copy of this order to each certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications company in Missouri and to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, NeuStar, Inc.

2. Any company wishing to intervene or request a hearing shall do so by filing an appropriate pleading no later than March 3, 2006, with:
