**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING DATE FOR INTERVENTION,
AND DIRECTING THE FILING OF A STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

On October 28, 2020, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application for a certificate of convenience and necessity to construct, install, own, operate, maintain, and otherwise control and manage a solar electric generating facility in Montgomery County, Missouri, to serve as the second program resource for its expanded Community Solar Program.¹

The Commission will provide notice of the application to the general public and interested parties and set a deadline for intervention requests. If no movant is granted intervention, and neither the Commission’s Staff nor the Office of the Public Counsel requests a hearing, the Commission may determine that a hearing is not necessary for a determination of the application.²

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission’s Data Center shall serve a copy of this order on the county commission for each county in the service territory of Ameren Missouri and on the Board of Alderman of the City of St. Louis.

2. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order on each of the parties in File Nos. EA-2016-0207 and ET-2020-0022.

3. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the Missouri General Assembly whose districts include the City of St. Louis and any county in the service territory of Ameren Missouri, and to media serving those areas.

4. Any application for intervention shall be filed no later than November 20, 2020. Any such filing shall be delivered to:

5. The Commission's Staff shall file a recommendation or a status report indicating when it expects to file a recommendation no later than December 4, 2020.
