JOINT PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through counsel, and proposes the procedural schedule set out below, to which the Staff, the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC") and Ameren Missouri have agreed.¹ Staff further states:

On July 15, 2022,² the Commission ordered the Staff to file a recommendation or status report stating when it expected to file a recommendation no later than August 30. On August 30, the Staff filed a Status Report and Procedural Recommendation. Because of the posture of discovery and other factors, Staff asked the Commission to allow it either to file a recommendation as soon as it could, or, in lieu, to file rebuttal testimony no later than December 21 in response to direct testimony. Staff also suggested a procedural schedule for surrebuttal, hearing dates and briefing. Ameren Missouri filed a response on September 9. After consultation, Staff, OPC and Ameren Missouri have agreed to the following procedural schedule:

Rebuttal Testimony	December 21, 2022
Surrebuttal Testimony	January 18, 2023
Hearings	February 6 – 8, 2023
All Briefing Completed	March 3, 2023

Responses to data requests	Five calendar days
Objections/Notice of need for more time to Respond	Two business days
