ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On August 4, 2005, the Commission issued an order opening this case to address the request of Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a SBC Missouri, for a waiver of the requirement of 4 CSR 240-29.040(4) that the originating Calling Party Number (CPN) be included in the 11-01-XX billing records for wireless-originated calls.¹ The order also established a procedural schedule that provides for the case to be concluded by September 30, 2005.

On August 8, 2005, the Commission's Staff filed a Joint Motion of All Parties to Suspend Procedural Schedule. Staff notes that the parties agree that the temporary waiver can and should be extended to allow the parties to meet and attempt to resolve this matter in an informal setting. Accordingly, the parties propose to file, no later than November 18, 2005, either a unanimous stipulation with respect to the waiver and waiver period, or if a unanimous stipulation cannot be reached, proposed procedural schedules. The parties also request that the temporary waiver be extended until November 30, 2005.

¹ In Case No. TX-2003-0301, the Commission granted SBC Missouri a temporary suspension, until September 30, 2005, of this provision in order to provide the Commission with sufficient time to review the matter.

The Commission finds that the motion to suspend the procedural schedule is reasonable and should be granted. The parties are thus expressly excused from the obligation to file direct testimony on August 17; rebuttal testimony on August 23; the list of issues, statements of positions, order of opening statements and witnesses and order of cross-examination on August 31; and briefs on September 14. The hearing set for September 7 is canceled. The Commission will set a deadline for the parties to file either a unanimous stipulation and agreement or proposed procedural schedules. In addition, the Commission will extend the temporary waiver of the requirement of 4 CSR 240-29.040(4) that the originating Calling Party Number be included in the 11-01-XX billing records for wireless-originated calls.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That the Joint Motion of All Parties to Suspend Procedural Schedule is granted.
- 2. That no later than November 18, 2005, the parties shall file either a unanimous stipulation and agreement or proposed procedural schedules.
- 3. That the waiver granted to Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a SBC Missouri, in Case No. TX-2003-0301, is extended from September 30, 2005, to November 30, 2005.

4. That this order shall become effective on August 12, 2005.
