ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE, BIFURCATING PROCEEDING, EXTENDING TEMPORARY WAIVER AND CHANGING STYLE OF CASE

Issue Date: March 1, 2006

Effective Date: March 1, 2006

On January 31, 2006, the Commission issued an order directing the parties to jointly or separately file a proposed procedural schedule. The parties have not been able to reach a unanimous agreement on a proposed procedural schedule.

On February 23, 2006, the Staff of the Commission, Missouri Independent Telephone Group, and Small Telephone Company Group filed a joint proposed procedural schedule and requested the issues be resolved through a bifurcated procedural schedule. The Commission finds that the joint procedural schedule proposed by Staff, MITG, and STCG is reasonable and it will be adopted. The Commission finds that the following conditions shall be applied:

(A) The Commission will require that testimony be electronically prefiled as defined in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.130. All parties must comply with this rule, including the requirement that testimony be filed on line-numbered pages. The practice of prefiling testimony is designed to give parties notice of the claims, contentions, and

evidence in issue and to avoid unnecessary objections and delays caused by allegations of unfair surprise at the hearing.

(B) If the parties do not reach agreement, the parties shall agree upon and the Staff shall file a list of the issues to be heard, the witnesses to appear on each day of the hearing and the order in which they will be called, and the order of cross-examination for each witness. Any issue not contained in this list of issues will be viewed as uncontested and not requiring resolution by the Commission.

(C) All parties are required to bring an adequate number of copies of exhibits that they intend to offer into evidence at any hearing. The party offering an exhibit shall bring, in addition to the copy for the court reporter, copies for the five Commissioners, the Presiding Judge, and all counsel.

(D) Any party wishing to do so, may file a pre-hearing brief on or before April 13, 2006.

(E) The parties will present oral argument at the conclusion of the evidentiary hearing, in lieu of filing post-briefs.

Staff, MITG, and STCG also proposed the Commission extend the current temporary waiver of the rules requirements by 30 days, from March 31, 2006, until April 30, 2006.

On February 23, 2006, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., filed notice with the Commission that the style of this case may be changed to reflect that Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. now does business as "AT&T Missouri."

- 1. The case will proceed following a bifurcated procedural schedule.
- 2. The following procedural schedule is established:

3. The hearing set forth in this order is scheduled to be held in Room 310 in the offices of the Missouri Public Service Commission, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. 4. The current temporary waiver of the rules requirements is extended by 30 days, from March 31, 2006, until April 30, 2006.

5. If the decision in this matter does not render moot the remaining issues, the parties will file a suggested procedural schedule for further proceedings within 10 days of the issuance of such decision.

6. The style of this case is changed to reflect that Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., now does business as "AT&T Missouri."
