On August 24, 2022, Grain Belt Express LLC (Grain Belt) filed an application seeking an order amending its certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) granted in File No. EA-2016-0358. On December 21, 2022, the Commission set a procedural schedule indicating that it would set local public hearings in early March.

Three in-person local public hearings have been requested and the Commission will set three hearings. However, the Commission will set only one in-person hearing and two hearings will be held via video and telephone conference at different times of day as set out below. The Commission will also direct Grain Belt to provide notice of the hearings and will establish procedural requirements for the hearings. The Commission will not conduct a question-and-answer session before the beginning of the hearings.

To facilitate an orderly presentation that can be preserved for the record, members of the public who wish to participate in the WebEx question-and-answer session or make comment to the Commission during a WebEx hearing shall register by sending their first and last name, phone number, and email address to pscinfo@psc.mo.gov, or by calling (800) 392-4211 by 5:00 p.m. the day before the hearing.

3. In-person hearings will not be broadcast by WebEx or by any other means. Those wishing to participate in the in-person hearings must attend in-person. No preregistration is needed for attending an in-person hearing. 4. Witness testimony at local public hearings shall be limited to five minutes per person. No person may donate their time for testimony to another witness in order to extend that witness's testimony time to more than five minutes.

5. A live audio web stream at the Commission's website, www.psc.mo.gov, will provide audio of the WebEx hearings. Those who do not intend to make comments to the Commission should listen via the web stream.

6. Grain Belt shall provide notice of the local public hearings by placing advertisements in newspapers serving Audrain, Callaway, and Monroe Counties at least ten (10) calendar days before the date of the local public hearing. The advertisements shall, at a minimum, inform persons of the date, time, location, and purpose of the hearings, shall provide the call-in and video login information, and shall be no smaller than 1/8 page in size.

10. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the media and the General Assembly representing customers in Audrain, Callaway, and Monroe Counties.

11. The Commission's Data Center shall mail a copy of this order to the county commissions for Audrain, Callaway, and Monroe Counties.

12. This order shall be effective when issued.
