**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING DEADLINE FOR  
INTERVENTION REQUESTS, AND DIRECTING FILING OF  
STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

On January 13, 2023, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application for a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) to construct, install, own, operate, maintain, and otherwise control a new 345 kV switchyard and associated facilities in Callaway County, Missouri. Ameren Missouri also requests waiver of the Commission’s rule requiring 60 days’ notice prior to filing an application.

The Commission will direct notice of the application be given to the Callaway County Commission, local newspapers, and members of the General Assembly representing residents of Callaway County. The Commission will set a deadline for interested parties to intervene. The Commission will direct its Staff to file a recommendation with regard to the application.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission’s Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the County Commission of Callaway County, Missouri.

2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Callaway County and to the media serving that county.

3. Any person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than February 14, 2023. The application shall be filed in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System (EFIS) or with the Secretary of the Commission.

4. No later than March 1, 2023, Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Applicants' application or a status report stating when it expects to file a recommendation.

5. This order shall be effective when issued.
