ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On June 12, 2018, the Commission's Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to grant a variance from the Commission's rules to allow Eligible Telecommunications Carriers (ETCs) additional time to submit certain information with the Commission. The Commission granted the requested variance on June 20, allowing the ETCs until July 16, 2018 to file that information. On June 19, Staff filed another request for variance. The new request for variance concerns the Commission's rule's requirement that the ETCs must file with the Commission a copy of the annual report (Form 481) they are required to file with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) under federal law.

Staff's motion explains the FCC has indicated it will no longer require ETCs to file duplicate copies of the Form 481 with the FCC and the state commissions, reasoning that the state commissions can now access that form on the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) website. Some Missouri ETCs have asked whether the Commission will continue to require them to file the duplicate forms with this Commission despite the change in the FCC's requirements. Staff asks the Commission to accept its request to consider this matter, and determine whether it is necessary for ETCs to file Form 481 with the Commission pursuant to 4 CSR 240-31.130(3)(A) for 2018.

The Commission has two questions for Staff. First, while Staff's motion explains the circumstances and asks the Commission to consider the matter and make a determination as to whether it is necessary for the ETCs to file Form 481 with the Commission, it never actually offers a recommendation to the Commission. Does Staff recommend the Commission grant the waiver requested by the ETCs? Second, Staff's motion refers only to 4 CSR 240-31.130(3)(A), which concerns ETCs receiving Lifeline support. The Commission notes that the same requirement to file a duplicate Form 481 also appears in 4 CSR 240-31.130(3)(B), which concerns ETCs receiving high-cost support. Does Staff also recommend the Commission waive application of that provision?

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a response to the Commission's questions no later than June 21, 2018.
 - 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
