ZONE AREA MAP

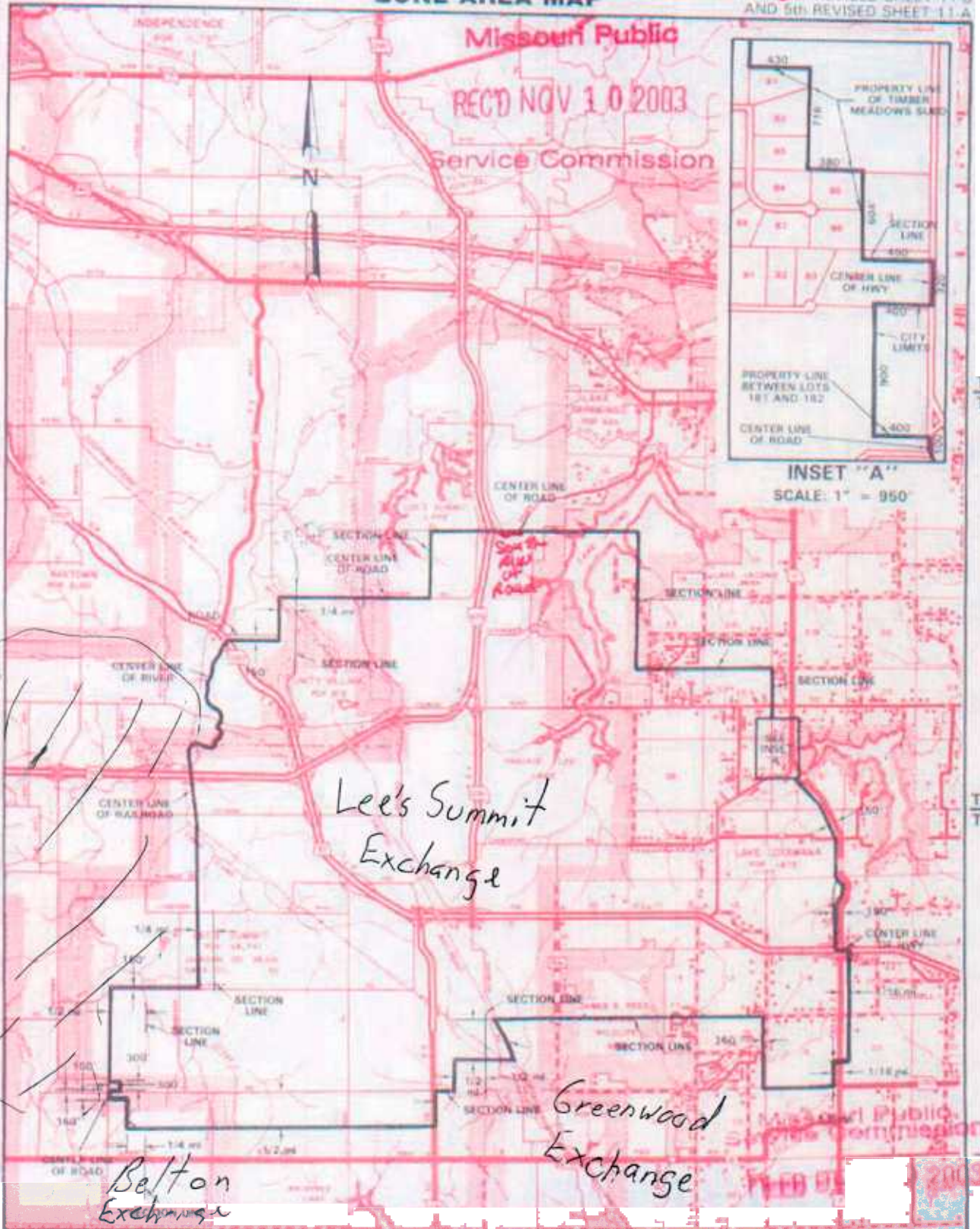

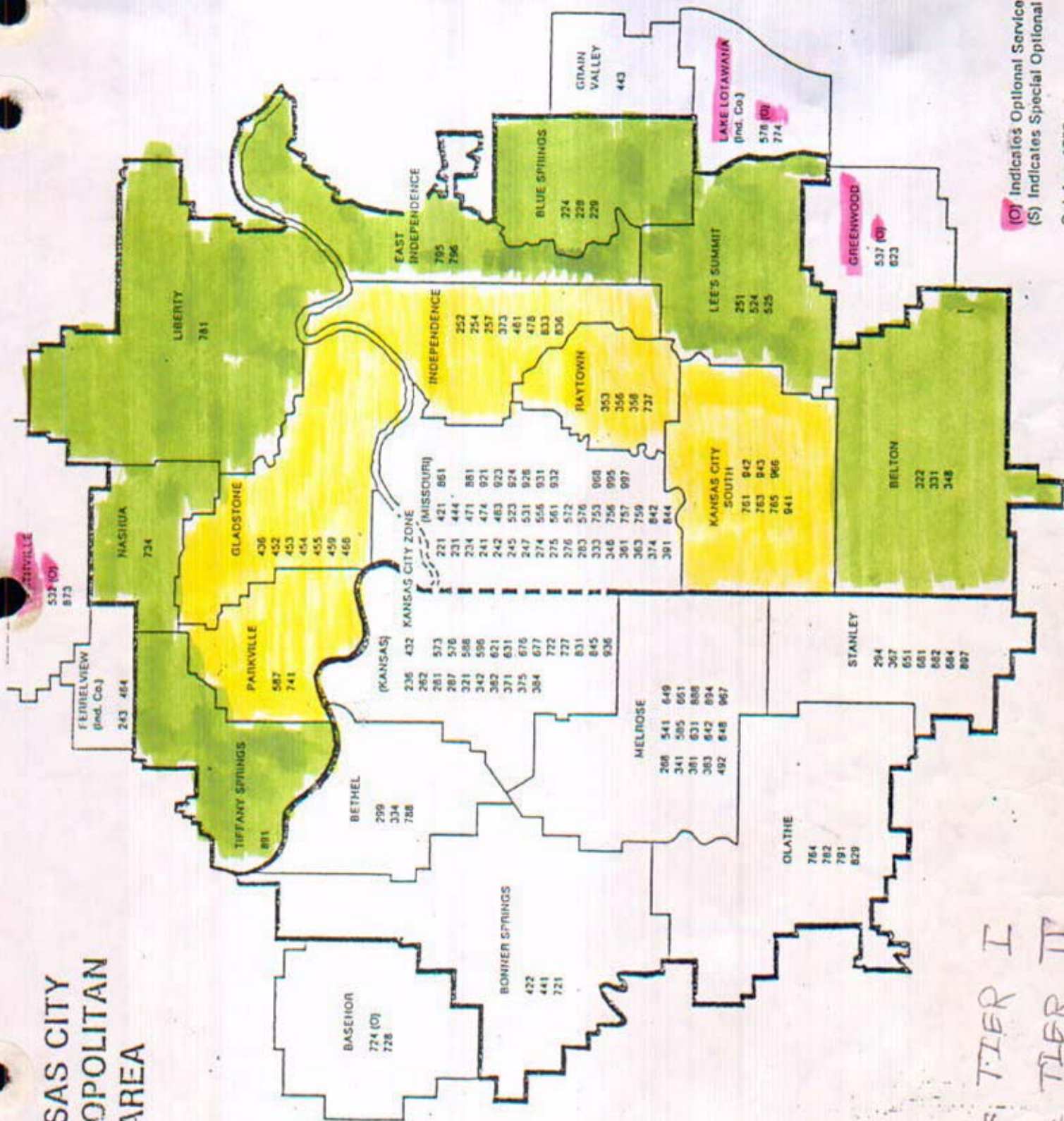

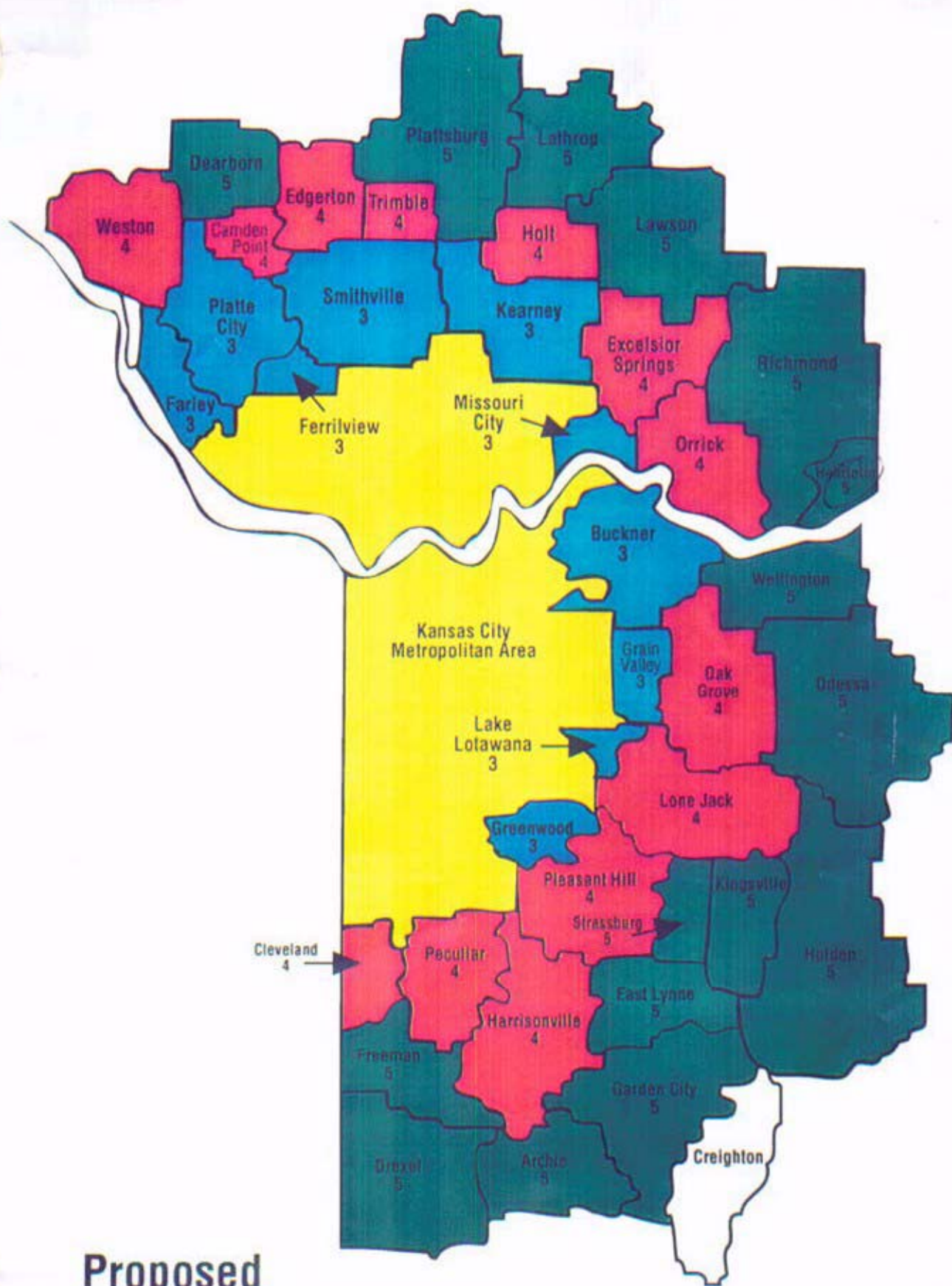
KANSAS CITY METROPOLITAN AREA

(FC) 1.6.1 Service Description

- A. Metropolitan Calling Area (MCA) service is available in three distinct areas in Missouri: the St. Louis MCA, the Kansas City MCA and the Springfield MCA.
- B. The St. Louis, Kansas City and Springfield Metropolitan Exchanges are included in the respective MCAs. The basic local calling scope for each of these exchanges is the MCA-wide calling scope 1.5.2, 1.5.3 and 1.5.4 of this tariff.
- C. In selected exchanges, MCA service is an optional service which provides the subscriber with an optional local calling area which includes the respective Metropolitan Exchange and certain customers in other exchanges where MCA service is also available, as described in Section 1.6.3 following.
- D. In each MCA, exchanges and Metropolitan Exchange Zones are grouped into different MCA rate classifications. In the St. Louis and Kansas City MCAs, exchanges where Optional MCA Service is available are classified as MCA-3, MCA-4 or MCA-5. In the Springfield MCA, exchanges where Optional MCA Service is available are classified as MCA-2.
