## ORDER CANCELING TARIFF

Issue Date: May 17, 2021

Effective Date: June 16, 2021

On March 29, 2021, Sprint Communications Company L.P. filed a letter requesting the Commission cancel its authority to provide local exchange and interexchange services in the State of Missouri. The letter states that Sprint is “hereby withdrawing Missouri Tariff Missouri P.S.C. Tariff No. 5 and Missouri Local Switching tariff filed in July 2017.”

On April 28, 2021, the Staff of the Commission filed a *Motion to Cancel Certificate of Service Authority* and recommended the Commission cancel the certificates of service authority issued to Sprint Communications to provide interexchange and competitive local exchange services.

On May 12, 2021, the Commission issued its order to cancel, effective June 11, 2021, the certificates of service authority issued to Sprint Communications to provide local exchange and interexchange services in Missouri.

Based on cancelation of the certificates of service authority and Sprint Communications’ withdrawal of the related tariffs, the Commission will cancel the associated tariff.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The following tariff, assigned Tariff No. JX-2004-0076, is canceled, effective June 16, 2021:

**Sprint Communications Company L.P., Missouri P.S.C. Tariff No. 5**

2. This order shall be effective on June 16, 2021.
3. The order to close this file on June 12, 2021, is vacated. This file shall close on June 17, 2021.
