On March 21, 2007, the Missouri Public Service Commission's Staff filed Staff's Motion to Classify In-Camera Transcript as Public Information. In that motion Staff contends that the testimony contained in Volume 3 of the official transcript of the January 25, 2007 evidentiary hearing, which is currently classified as highly confidential, should be reclassified as public information.

The Commission would like a response from MCC Telephony concerning its position on this issue. Because the due dates for briefs are rapidly approaching, the Commission will direct MCC Telephony to file its response to Staff's motion no later than 1:00 p.m. on Friday, March 23, 2007. Any other party wishing to file a response to Staff's motion must do so no later than 1:00 p.m., Friday, March 23, 2007.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. MCC Telephony of Missouri, Inc., shall file a response to the Staff's Motion to Classify In-Camera Transcript as Public Information no later than 1:00 p.m., Friday, March 23, 2007.

2. Any party wishing to respond to Staff's Motion to Classify In-Camera Transcript as Public Information shall file its response no later than 1:00 p.m., Friday, March 23, 2007.

3. This order shall become effective on March 21, 2007.
