On April 25, 2006, MCC Telephony of Missouri, Inc. filed an application with the Commission requesting a waiver of compliance with the requirements of 4 CSR 240-32.080(5)(A)1 related to time standards for installation of service. On April 28, 2006, the Office of the Public Counsel filed an objection to MCC Telephony's application contending, among other things, that MCC Telephony failed to state "good cause" for the requested waiver. On May 1, 2006, the Missouri Independent Telephone Company Group, comprised of six small rural ILECs, filed an "Application to Intervene in Opposition to Waiver." The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed its recommendation and supporting memorandum on July 11, 2006.

The next step is to move this matter toward resolution. To that end, the Commission will order any party wishing to request an evidentiary hearing in this case to do so on or before July 28, 2006. If no party requests an evidentiary hearing, the Commission will make its decision based upon the verified pleadings filed in this docket.

1. Any party wishing to request an evidentiary hearing in this case must do so on
