**JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

COMES NOW the parties to this case and request an extension of time to file a proposed procedural schedule in this matter. In support of their request, the parties state:

1. On March 2, 2005 the Commission conducted a conference among the parties to receive suggestions from the parties on how to proceed on remand in these matters. The Commission subsequently issued an order directing the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule by not later than March 21, 2005.

2. The five parties to this case have commenced their discussions on what such a procedural schedule may contain, but have not yet reached an agreement. At this time, the parties do anticipate such an agreement may be reached but require additional time to do so.

3. Accordingly, the parties request an extension of time to file a proposed procedural schedule in this matter for an additional week, until March 28, 2005.

4. The Commission's regulation at 4 CSR 240-2.050(3)(A) provides that the Commission may enlarge a specified time period before its expiration.

WHEREFORE, the parties request that the Commission grant an extension for an additional week, to March 28, 2005, to file a proposed procedural schedule in this matter.
