On October 4, 2007, First Communications, LLC, submitted tariff sheets proposing new calling plans and adding a monthly recurring charge to other calling plans for interexchange telecommunications services. The effective date of the tariff sheets was November 7, 2007.

On October 29, 2007, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion requesting suspension of the tariff sheets. Staff filed its response on November 2, 2007, recommending the Commission deny the motion to suspend the tariffs.

In an Order Denying Motion to Suspend Tariff and Directing Corrected Customer Notice issued November 6, 2007, the Commission determined that First Communications should send an additional customer notice to its customers clarifying that the new monthly recurring charges were not authorized to begin until the effective date of the tariff and that no billing fee has been authorized. Staff was directed to investigate whether non-tariffed rates or fees were charged and to report its findings.

Staff has attached First Communications' corrected customer notice and its signed affidavit stating that it did not charge customers any non-tariffed charges.

Staff is satisfied with First Communications' responses and does not wish to bring any complaint.
