ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO FILE COMMENTS OUT OF TIME

On January 15, 2014, the Commission issued a notice inviting interested stakeholders to file comments about the possible creation of a Missouri Universal Service High-Cost Fund. That notice conveyed Staff’s request that such comments be filed no later than February 14. T-Mobile Central, LLC filed comments on February 18, the next business day after February 14. Along with its comments, T-Mobile filed a motion asking leave to file its comments out of time.

T-Mobile’s motion for leave to file out of time is unnecessary. T-Mobile was under no obligation to file comments and the February 14 filing date was merely a suggestion rather than a firm deadline. Nevertheless, to avoid any confusion or adverse implication, the Commission will grant that motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. T-Mobile Central, LLC’s Motion File Comments Out of Time is granted.
2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
