2. As the basis of this complaint, Complainant states the following facts:

The accident happened while clearing scrub brush and encroaching trees on pasture where we keep and maintain our cattle. I hit an unmarked guy wire, which was in an area grown up by trees. The trees had gotten so tall many had the tops burned out by contact with UE electric lines. At the time the lineman arrived, I pointed out the wire was unmarked and not visible. After the repair, I noted the new guy wire was marked and the pole had been upgraded to a noticeably better class. I discontinued clearing believing the UE crew would cut down trees that were just out of contact with wire, they are still there. I have been told other rural electric companies do not charge farms for contact with unmarked guy wires in farming areas, if it is not a habit. I have cleared for over three years on this farm, which has miles of lines, with no accidents. This accident did not result in any customer electric loss; the pole cracked and broke, but never fell. I feel I was charged extremely excessive labor and replacement cost. After the bill arrived, I spoke to Terry Kicielinski about the upgraded pole and she immediately reduced the bill by a small amount, as noted on a separate letter, This gesture was appreciated, but does very little to explain the excessive bill.
