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3 Q. And you're not providing the integrated T-1
4 products currently in the other exchanges where you're --
5 that you identified earlier?

6 A. Right. That was differentiated on the Data
7 Request response to you, or actually to Staff.

8 Q. Where Socket is offerating (sic) -- offering
9 -- excuse me.

10 Where Socket is providing the inbound
11 ISDN PRI service to Internet service providers, does Socket
12 have E911 listings associated with that?

13 A. Initially when Socket first provisioned the
14 service, the first few circuits that were turned up, a few of
15 those did get put into the 911 database. Socket's current
16 practice is not to include those in the 911 database.

17 Q. All right. And have you removed the E911
18 listings for that integrated -- excuse me -- for that inbound
19 ISDN PRI service where you had put them in originally?

20 A. No, we have not.

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14 Q. Does Socket provide unregulated services in
15 the exchanges that we've identified previously where it's
16 currently providing regulated service?

17 A. As far as for the exchanges where we're
18 offering the integrated T-1 product?

19 Q. Both sets of products.

20 A. Certainly where the integrated T-1 product is
21 offered, yes. In the other exchanges, not necessarily.

22 Q. Okay. Are these questions about the
23 additional services, are they confidential or not? Because
24 I'm going to ask about them.

25 A. I guess I'll have to hear them.

1 Q. What services do you provide, then, that are
2 unregulated in the areas where you're providing the regulated
3 integrated T-1?

4 A. In some of those areas Socket will provide
5 dedicated data services.

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
