ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND ESTABLISHING DATE FOR
INTERVENTION

On April 22, 2005, USCOC of Greater Missouri, LLC, d/b/a U.S. Cellular, filed its application with the Missouri Public Service Commission for designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier with respect to federal universal service support under Section 214 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 and the implementing regulations of the Federal Communications Commission.

Proper persons should be allowed an opportunity to file a motion for leave to intervene. Notice of this application should be sent to all incumbent and competitive local exchange carriers certificated to provide services in Missouri.
