ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, ESTABLISHING TIME FOR FILING REQUESTS TO INTERVENE, AND ESTABLISHING TIME FOR FILING RECOMMENDATIONS

This order directs notice of the case to be sent to all certificated basic local exchange telecommunications companies in the state of Missouri and to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator. The order also establishes dates for the filing of requests to intervene and for the filing of recommendations.

On May 2, 2005, Socket Telecom, LLC, filed an application under 47 C.F.R. 52.15 requesting that the Commission overturn a decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, Neustar, Inc., and to grant it a waiver of the minimum telephone number utilization requirements for growth codes set forth in 47 C.F.R. §52.15(g) of the rules of the Federal Communications Commission. This application is for the Springfield rate center.

The Commission finds that proper persons should be allowed 8 days from the issuance of this order to file a request for intervention or a motion for hearing. The Commission will direct its Data Center to send a copy of this order to each certificated basic local exchange telecommunications company in Missouri. In addition, the Data Center

shall send a copy of this order to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, NeuStar, Inc.

The Commission will also direct its Staff to file a recommendation and will establish a

date by which any other party wishing to respond must file a recommendation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Data Center shall send a copy of this order to each certificated basic

local exchange telecommunications company in Missouri and to the North American

Numbering Plan Administrator, NeuStar, Inc.

2. That any party wishing to intervene or to request a hearing shall do so by

filing an appropriate pleading no later than May 11, 2005, with:
