MOTION FOR ISSUANCE OF A PROTECTIVE ORDER

Comes now Spectra Communications Group, LLC ("Spectra") and pursuant to rule 4 CSR 240-2.085 moves the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") to issue its standard-form protective order in the above-referenced case. In support thereof, Spectra respectfully states to the Commission as follows:

- 1. On July 12, 2002, Spectra filed tariff revisions to its PSC MO No.2 "Facilities for Intrastate Access" tariff designed to change deposit regulations related to its ability to request security deposits from carriers whose credit worthiness had fallen below commercially acceptable levels. This tariff bore an effective date of August 11, 2002.
- 2. On August 7, MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc. ("WorldCom") filed a Motion to Suspend the tariff. On August 8, the Commission issued its Order Suspending Tariff for thirty (30) days, and on September 5 the Commission issued an Order Further Suspending Tariff, Directing Notice, and Scheduling Prehearing Conference. In this Order the tariff was suspended until December 9, 2002.
- 3. On September 30, the parties met in prehearing conference and agreed on a procedural schedule. In this conference the parties also discussed the necessity for discovery. Because Spectra anticipates that there may be requests for discovery of information that the company will consider "proprietary" or "highly confidential," it requests that the Commission

issue a Protective Order so that these documents may be treated in accordance with the terms of the Commission's rule regarding confidential or proprietary information. Public disclosure of this information to potential competitors could cause substantial harm to Spectra. None of the information for which a claim of confidentiality will be made can be found in any format in any other public document.

4. Therefore, because of the potential for public disclosure of such confidential information without a protective order in place, Spectra moves the Commission to issue its standard-form protective order containing classifications of "highly confidential" and "proprietary."

WHEREFORE, Spectra respectfully requests that the Commission:

- (a) issue the Commission's standard-form protective order containing classifications of "highly confidential" and "proprietary" to guide the parties' conduct in this case; and,
 - (b) grant such further relief as the Commission deems appropriate.
