ORDER SHORTENING TIME IN WHICH TO RESPOND

Issue Date: September 15, 2005

Effective Date: September 15, 2005

On September 13, 2005, Socket Telecom, LLC filed a motion asking the Commission to suspend or reject tariffs filed by CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel and Spectra Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel. 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) provides that parties are allowed not more than ten days in which to respond to any pleading unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. Because the CenturyTel tariffs carry an effective date of September 30, the Commission must deal with Socket's motion expeditiously. For that reason, the Commission will shorten the time allowed for the filing of a response to Socket's motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That any party wishing to respond to Socket Telecom, LLC's Motion to Suspend or Reject Proposed Tariff Sheets shall do so on or before September 21, 2005.

2. That this order shall become effective on September 15, 2005.
