ORDER DIRECTING FILING AND SHORTENING TIME IN WHICH TO RESPOND

On June 15, 2006, AT&T Communications of Southwest, Inc., and AT&T Missouri (collectively, the "AT&T Companies") filed a motion asking the Missouri Public Service Commission to suspend and investigate tariffs filed by McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services. Section 15 of 4 CSR 240-2.080 provides that parties are allowed not more than ten days in which to respond to any pleading unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. Because the McLeodUSA tariffs carry an effective date of June 23rd, the Commission must address the AT&T Companies' motion expeditiously. For that reason, the Commission will shorten the time allowed for the filing of a response to the motion. The Commission will also need to have a recommendation from its Staff before acting on the motion.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to AT&T Missouri's Motion to Suspend and Investigate Tariff shall do so on or before June 20, 2006.

2. The Staff of the Commission shall file a recommendation regarding the motion by June 20, 2006.

3. This order shall become effective on June 16, 2006.
