## **ORDER REGARDING TARIFF**

Issue Date: June 27, 2006

Effective Date: July 1, 2006

On June 23, 2006, Sprint Communications Company, L.P., filed its tariff designed to implement the contractual terms agreed to by it and the Commission for the provision of Telephone Relay Service (Relay Service) in Missouri. Concurrent with the its tariff filing, Sprint filed a Motion for Expedited Treatment requesting the tariff be approved to become effective on July 1, 2006, to correspond to the date the new Relay Service contract goes into effect.

On June 26, 2006, Staff filed a recommendation urging the Commission to approve Sprint's relay service tariff to become effective July 1, 2006. The Staff indicated that the proposed tariff reflects the terms contained in the contract for Relay Service the Commission awarded to Sprint.

Having considered all the verified pleadings filed in this case, which are hereby admitted into evidence, the Commission finds that the proposed tariff and the rates it establishes for telecommunications relay services are reasonable and consistent with the contractual terms contained in the relay telecommunications services contract awarded to Sprint. Furthermore, the tariff will be approved to become effective on July 1, 2006, to coincide with the beginning date of the new contract.
