On July 12, 2007, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion asking the Commission to suspend a tariff filed by Navigator Telecommunications, LLC. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties not more than ten days in which to respond to any pleading unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. Because Navigator's tariff carries an effective date of July 20, the Commission must deal with Public Counsel's motion expeditiously. For that reason, the Commission will shorten the time allowed for filing a response to Public Counsel's motion.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to Public Counsel's Motion to Suspend shall do so on or before July 17, 2007.

2. This order shall become effective on July 13, 2007.
