## ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO PUBLIC COUNSEL'S OBJECTION TO INCREASED CHARGE

AT&T Long Distance has filed tariffs to implement rate increases for monthly recurring charges on certain competitive long distance service plans the company offers in Missouri. On May 28, 2008, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a pleading stating its objection to the increased charges and asks the Commission to "decline to approve the tariff". The challenged tariffs carry an effective date of June 12. If the Commission is to act on Public Counsel's pleading before the tariffs go into effect it must do so at its June 10 agenda meeting. Therefore, the Commission will establish June 4 as the deadline for the filing of responses to Public Counsel's pleading.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Any party that wants to respond to Public Counsel's Objection to Increased Charge shall do so no later than June 4, 2008.

2. This order shall become effective on May 30, 2008.
