FISCAL NOTE REVIEW MEMORANDUM

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”) and states:

1. In the Memorandum attached as Appendix A, the Staff advises the Commission that the Staff conducted a review of the fiscal estimates from the rule changes adopted in this case and has determined that no fiscal estimate changes need to be filed with the Secretary of State.

2. This rulemaking made changes to the Commission’s rules governing service and billing practices for telecommunications companies. The Commission’s Orders of Rulemaking appeared in the August 16, 2004 *Missouri Register*, Volume 29, Number 16, at pages 1258 through 1265, amending rules at 4 CSR 240-33.010, 4 CSR 240-33.020, 4 CSR 240-33.040, 4 CSR 240-33.060, 4 CSR 240-33.070, 4 CSR 240-33.080, 4 CSR 240-33.110, 4 CSR 240-33.150, and 4 CSR 240-3.555. The rules became effective on September 30, 2004, 30 days after their publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.

3. Section 536.200.2 RSMo. (2000) requires agencies to make a filing with the Secretary of State if, after the first full year after implementation, the cost of the rule exceeds the agency estimate. The first full fiscal year after the rules became effective was the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005 and ending June 30, 2006.
