JUDGE GRAHAM: This is the case of William C. Fox, Sr., Complainant, v. Missouri-American Water Company, Respondent. File No. WC-2019-0084. It's now 1:15, and we are in the Governor's Building conducting a procedural conference that was earlier set. My name's Paul Graham, and I'm the regulatory law judge in this matter. And we're going to begin by having the parties make their entries of appearance.

Let the record reflect that at an earlier date, the Commission did issue an order setting this conference for today. And the Commission will now take official notice of the order that set this matter for a procedural conference today, and will officially take notice of the contents of that order. In that order, the Commission will do -- will officially notice it did require the parties to be present, in person or by attorney, and if not in person, by telephone. And that order gave out the necessary contact information for all parties, or any party to be able to attend this particular meeting.

That in mind, I have made the call. Is William C. Fox, Sr., present? Is he present by phone?

13 JUDGE GRAHAM: And is someone here for
14 Missouri-American Water Company?

15 MS. CARTER: Yes. Diana Carter with Brydon,
16 Swearengen, and England. And my contact information is
17 on the written entry provided to the court reporter.

18 JUDGE GRAHAM: And is anyone here from Public
19 Counsel? I don't know of any appearance being entered.
20 And the record will show that no one has appeared on
21 behalf of the Public Counsel.

22 Well, I believe that 4CSR240-2.090(5) makes
23 provision for the failure of a party to appear. And
24 the Commission is going to judicially or officially
25 notice all of the applicable regulations in that

1 regard. Let me think through my checklist here of what
2 I need to take official notice of under these
3 circumstances.

4 Just so the record's clear, the access number
5 for this hearing that I called in on was 877-820-7831.
6 The pin number for others was provided, 97399657
7 hashmark. The Commission's going to officially notice
8 that all of that information was provided to the
9 Complainant.

10 And with that, are there any other matters or
11 recitations into the record that any party wishes to
12 make, or think should be made?

13 MS. ASLIN: Nothing from Staff.

14 MS. CARTER: I have nothing. Thank you.

15 JUDGE GRAHAM: That said, we are going to
16 close the hearing and go off the record.
