**APPLICATION OF TELEGLOBE AMERICA INC.
FOR A CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY
AND FOR COMPETITIVE CLASSIFICATION**

Teleglobe America Inc. ("TAI" or "Applicant"), through undersigned counsel and pursuant to Sections 392.361, 392.410, 392.420, 392.430, and 392.440 RSMo.; 4 CSR 240-2.060 and 4 CSR 240-3.510 hereby requests that the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") issue TAI a Certificate of Service Authority to provide intrastate interexchange and non-switched local telecommunications service within the State of Missouri, classify TAI as a competitive company, and waive certain statutes and rules. In support of this Application, TAI states as follows:

A. Description of the Applicant

1. TAI, f/k/a TLGB Corporation,¹ is a Delaware corporation located at 12010 Sunset Hills Road, Reston, Virginia, 20190. Copies of TAI's Certificate of Incorporation and Certificate of Amendment of Certificate of Incorporation are attached as Exhibit A. A copy of TAI's certificate of qualification to transact business in Missouri is attached as Exhibit B. TAI is generally in the business of providing telecommunications services.

B. Qualifications

3. TAI is financially qualified to provide telecommunications services in Missouri.
4. TAI also has the managerial and technical resources necessary to operate in Missouri. Biographies of TAI's management personnel are provided in Exhibit C.

C. Description of Services

5. TAI seeks authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services and private line services throughout the State of Missouri. Therefore, TAI seeks statewide authority. Its services are expected to include long distance toll services, dedicated inbound or outbound calling services as well as non-switched direct channel line(s) dedicated to a customer's use between specified points. It will also provide services to other carriers involved in the provision of interexchange services.

6. TAI will provide all such services in accord with its tariffs. TAI's proposed interexchange tariff is being filed simultaneously with this Application and is attached hereto as Exhibit D. The proposed tariff contains the rules and regulations applicable to its customers, a description of the services offered, and a list of the rates associated with such services. The tariff has a forty-five (45) day effective date, as required by 4 CSR 240-3.510 (1)(c).

7. TAI will continuously monitor and maintain a high level of control over its network on a 24-hours-a-day, 7 days-a-week basis.

8. TAI will not unjustly discriminate among its subscribers, as prohibited by Section 392.200 RSMo.

9. TAI does not have any pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court that involve customer service or customer rates, which action, judgment or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of this Application.

10. Since TAI is requesting certification as a new carrier, no annual reports or fees are overdue to the Commission.

D. Classification as a Competitive Company

11. TAI seeks classification as a competitive company, pursuant to Sections 392.361.2 and 392.361.3 RSMo., and the accompanying reduced regulation, pursuant to Section 392.420 RSMo.

12. Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission suspend, waive, or modify the application of the following rules and statutory provisions consistent with the Commission's treatment of other competitive carriers:

13. The above-referenced statutory provisions or regulations have been waived with regard to other competitive carriers. These statutory provisions or regulations are principally designed to apply to noncompetitive telecommunications carriers. It would be inconsistent with the goal and purpose of Section 392.530 RSMo. to apply them to a competitive telecommunications carrier such as Applicant.

14. TAI will comply with all orders and regulations of the Commission applicable to providers of competitive interexchange telecommunication services except those that are specifically waived by the Commission.

15. To the extent that the Commission may modify its current waiver policies, TAI reserves the right to amend its waiver requests accordingly.

E. Public Interest Considerations

16. Applicant believes that granting the requested certificate is in the public interest for the following reasons:

(a) Applicant's proposed intrastate telecommunications services are developed to serve the long distance needs of carriers and their subscribers who can not otherwise realize similar cost savings through other means.

(b) An increase in the traffic generated through provision of Applicant's proposed intrastate services over existing major carriers' communications facilities will improve the efficiency and reduce major carriers' costs in provision of these services.

(c) The public will benefit through the broadening of innovative telecommunications service alternatives and ongoing affordable rates maintained by the additional competitive pressure placed on other competitors.

G. CONCLUSION

For the reasons stated above, Applicant respectfully submits that the public interest, convenience, and necessity would be furthered by a grant of this Application for a Certificate of Service Authority to provide intrastate interexchange and non-switched local telecommunications services, classify TAI and its proposed services as competitive, and grant a waiver of the statutes and regulations referenced above.

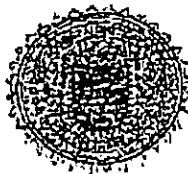

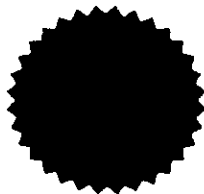

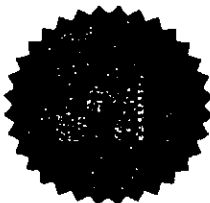

1. The name of the corporation is TLGB Corporation (the "Corporation").

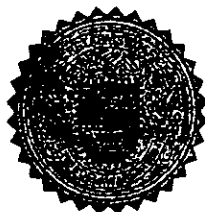

Liam Gerald Porter Strong, President and Chief Executive Officer, Director

Liam Strong is President and Chief Executive Officer of Teleglobe America Inc. From 1997 to 2001, he was the President and Chief Executive Officer of MCI WorldCom International (global voice communications carrier), responsible for the development and execution of the company's successful expansion in Europe and Asia. From 1992 to 1997, Mr. Strong was the Chief Executive Officer of Sears PLC, a retailer of apparel and home services. Prior to 1992, he was the Marketing and Operations Director of British Airways. Mr. Strong is Chairman of the Advisory Board on Telecom Security to the UK Government and a member of the Governing Council of the Ashridge Business School.

Serge Fortin, Chief Operating Officer

Serge Fortin is Chief Operating Officer of Teleglobe America Inc. Serge Fortin has in excess of 27 years experience in the telecommunications industry covering both national and international markets. He served as President of Bell Actimedia where he directed the business associated with the traditional Yellow Pages directory evolving it to develop synergy between the traditional advertising media to the e-World (Sympatico portal and the ISPs). Between 1996 and 1998 he served as President of TATA Telecommunications Services in India, which offered basic telecommunications services in the state of Andra Pradesh. Prior to joining Teleglobe, Serge Fortin has held several senior positions in Operations, Engineering, Sales and Marketing at Bell Canada.

Among some of his major achievements are: in 1983, he launched the cellular business in Canada; he implemented the first enhanced 911 service in Canada; and succeeded in achieving the first Canadian Telco ISO Certification. He was the first Officer to be appointed to deal with the new entrants in the Long Distance markets in 1992 following the CRTC decision. He was also the first Officer to lead the National Long Distance portfolio at Stentor. Between 1993 and 1996 Mr. Fortin was one of the pioneers to establish Teleglobe Inc. and its affiliates on the International Market.

Prior to joining Teleglobe, Rick spent 12 years at General Electric ("GE") where he held senior positions in various GE businesses, including Chief Financial Officer of GE Superabrasives, Manager of Planning & Finance for GE Employers Reinsurance, and several global assignments in GE Plastics. Mr. Willett was a member of GE's Corporate Audit Staff with responsibility for assessing business units. Mr. Willett has a degree in Chemical Engineering and a Masters in Business Administration.

Henri Alexandre, Vice-President, Engineering and Provisioning

Henri Alexandre is Vice-President, Engineering and Provisioning at Teleglobe America Inc. Mr. Alexandre will direct the planning, engineering and implementation of the international network required to support voice and data services. He leads a team of experts in subsea cables, satellite systems, terrestrial transmission systems, voice switching and data transmission systems.

Mr. Alexandre has more than 20 years of international telecommunications experience. During the last 10 years, he held several Engineering and Management positions at Teleglobe, Inc. to include: Director - Satellite and Broadcast Services; Director - Network Engineering; Director - Network Architecture; and Associate Director - Switching Engineering.

Mr. Alexandre's major achievements include:

- Implementation of the private leased services backbone
- Introduction of voice customer direct access to Teleglobe's switched network
- Automation of Canada Home Country Direct Service

Mr. Jose Tetrault, Treasurer, has spent the last ten years in Treasury, the last six of those specific to the telecommunications industry.

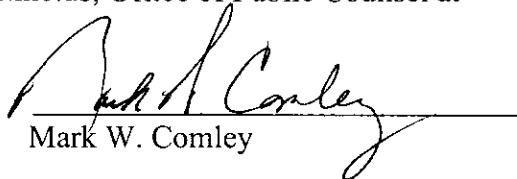

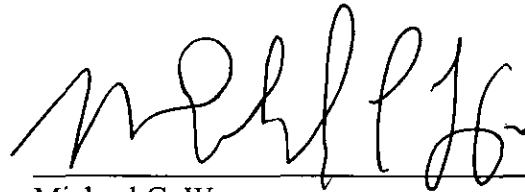
