## ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEETS IN COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDER

Issue Date: October 4, 2006 Effective Date: October 30, 2006

On February 23, 2006, the Commission issued an order approving a Stipulation and Agreement filed by the Staff of the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, and Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri, in which the parties agreed, among other things, that the exchanges of Washington, Beaufort, St. Clair, and Union would be added to Tier 5 of the St. Louis Metropolitan Calling Area (MCA). The order directed AT&T Missouri to file tariff sheets with an effective date that is the earliest possible date the provisions of the Stipulation can be implemented. AT&T Missouri submitted tariff sheets (Tariff File No. YI-2006-0695) on March 15, 2006, with an effective date of October 30, 2006.

Staff filed its recommendation and memorandum on September 14, 2006. Staff states that AT&T Missouri's proposed tariff outlines the terms, conditions, and rates as contained in the Stipulation. Accordingly, Staff has no objection to AT&T Missouri's proposed tariff filing and recommends that the Commission approve the tariff sheets to become effective on October 30, 2006. Staff also noted that within this case, CenturyTel of

Missouri, LLC, also has a tariff filing pending which addresses the exchanges of Foley, Holstein, Marthasville, Warrenton, and Wright City, and which will be addressed in a separate filing by Staff.

The Commission has reviewed the record in this matter, including Tariff No. YI-2006-0695, and the Staff's recommendation and memorandum. The Commission finds that the tariff complies with the Commission's previous order. The Commission shall, therefore, approve AT&T Missouri's tariff.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Tariff No. YI-2006-0695, filed by Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri, on March 15, 2006, is approved for service rendered on or after October 30, 2006. The tariff sheets approved are:
