ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO DISMISS CASE

On February 28, 2006, Missouri RSA No. 7 Limited Partnership, d/b/a Mid-Missouri Cellular, filed a Status Report and Voluntary Dismissal of its application for designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier (ETC) for purposes of the Universal Service Fund. In its voluntary dismissal, the company stated that the sale of all Mid-Missouri Cellular assets had been approved and that the company was no longer eligible for ETC status. Therefore, the company stated that it was voluntarily dismissing its application.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.116 states that once evidence is filed, the applicant may only dismiss a case with leave of the Commission. Written direct testimony has been filed by the applicant in this case. No purpose would be served by continuing this case and therefore the Commission grants leave to dismiss this case.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Leave to dismiss this case is granted.
- 2. This case is voluntarily dismissed.
- 3. This order shall become effective on March 17, 2006.
- 4. This case may be closed on March 18, 2006.
