### **ORDER RESCHEDULING LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING**

On August 30, 2005, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a SBC Missouri, filed its petition for competitive classification pursuant to Section 392.245.5, RSMo (2005). On September 27, 2005, the Missouri Public Service Commission scheduled a local public hearing on October 7, 2005, in Moberly, Missouri.<sup>1</sup> Due to a scheduling conflict, the Commission must reschedule the local public hearing to October 3, 2005. As noted in the previous order, the local public hearing shall be conducted by means of videoconferencing. It is anticipated that members of the Commission and the Commission's Staff will participate in the videoconference from the Commission's offices in Jefferson City, Missouri. Members of the public may appear at either the Moberly location or at the Commission's offices in Jefferson City.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That a local public hearing shall be held on October 3, 2005, at 7:00 p.m., at the following location:

Moberly Area Community College

101 College Avenue,  
Moberly, Missouri 65270

7:00 p.m.

The local public hearing will commence promptly at 7:00 p.m. and shall continue until every member of the public in attendance has had an opportunity to testify, but in no case later than 9:00 p.m. The local public hearing shall be held in a facility that meets the accessibility requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. Any person who needs additional accommodations to participate in the hearing should call the Public Service Commission's Hotline at 1-800-392-4211 (voice) or Relay Missouri at 711 prior to the hearing.

2. That the local public hearing shall be conducted by means of videoconferencing. Therefore, any person may attend the local public hearing in Moberly or in Jefferson City at the date and time listed in Ordered Paragraph 1. The Jefferson City location is the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, Room 310. The Governor Office Building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. Anyone needing additional accommodations to participate in the hearing should call the Public Service Commission's Hotline at 1-800-392-4211 (voice) or Relay Missouri at 711 prior to the hearing.

3. That during the half-hour preceding the local public hearing, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service shall be available to answer questions from members of the public.

4. That the Commission's Public Information Office shall make this order or the information contained in this order available to the media serving the exchanges in which Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a SBC Missouri, seeks competitive classification.

5. That the Commission shall make arrangements for a court reporter for the local public hearing.

6. That this order shall become effective on September 28, 2005.
