ORDER ESTABLISHING PROTECTIVE ORDER

On October 4, 2005, a number of small rural carriers¹ filed a petition for arbitration with the Missouri Public Service Commission pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996, requesting that the Commission arbitrate unresolved issues with Sprint PCS. With the petition, petitioners filed a Motion for Protective Order.

Upon review of the motion, the Commission finds that there is a need to protect confidential information and that the request for a protective order is reasonable. The Commission has previously recognized the need to protect confidential information and the issuance of protective orders has helped to minimize disputes in past cases. Therefore, a protective order should be established.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Motion for Protective Order filed by Petitioners is granted and the protective order attached to this order (Attachment A) is adopted.
