NOTICE OF INTENDED CASE FILING

Transource Missouri, LLC ("Transource Missouri" or "Company"), pursuant to 4 CSR 240-4.020, hereby files this Notice of Intended Case Filing and respectfully states to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"):

- 1. Transource Missouri is a Delaware limited liability company qualified to conduct business in Missouri, with its principal place of business located at 1 Riverside Plaza, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
- 2. Transource Missouri is a transmission-owning entity regulated by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission. Its business is devoted exclusively to constructing, financing, owning, operating and maintaining transmission facilities that provide wholesale, interstate electric transmission service via the Open-Access Transmission Tariff of Southwest Power Pool, Inc. The Company is not a Missouri rate-regulated entity and does not serve retail electric customers in Missouri. In 2013 the Commission granted a line certificate of convenience and necessity ("CCN") to the Company. See In re Transource Missouri, LLC, No. EA-2013-0098 (Aug. 7, 2013).
 - 3. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-4.020(2) states in pertinent part:

Any regulated entity that intends to file a case likely to be a contested case shall file a notice with the secretary of the commission a minimum of sixty (60) days prior to filing such case. Such notice shall detail the type of case and issues likely to be before the commission.

- 4. Because Transource Missouri does not believe that this matter is "likely to be a contested case," it is not clear that 4 CSR 240-4.020 would apply to this proceeding. However, out of an abundance of caution, the Company submits this Notice of Intended Case Filing.
- 5. Transource Missouri intends to file an application for a CCN similar to the application which it filed on January 19, 2016 in Case No. EA-2016-0188. The application to be filed in this proceeding will be for a different switch yard facility in northwest Missouri. The Company expects to submit its application to the Commission within 60 days of this notice or shortly thereafter.

WHEREFORE, Transource Missouri, LLC submits this Notice of Intended Case Filing.
