NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF ARBITRATION PETITION

Comes now T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("T-Mobile"), the Petitioner herein, and notifies the Commission that it wishes to withdraw its Petition for Arbitration, and requests that the Commission allow the withdrawal. The parties, T-Mobile and Spectra Communications Group, have reached agreement on the terms of an interconnection agreement, which they will be shortly be submitting to the Commission for approval. T-Mobile also requests that the Commission cancel the November 13, 2002, prehearing conference and rescind its order that the parties take those actions specified in its Order of October 15, 2002, in this case.
