## NOTICE DISMISSING COMPLAINT AND CLOSING CASE

On December 17, 2004, Lula M. Fabyanic filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission a complaint against VarTec Telecom, Inc., alleging that the company took unreasonable delays in transferring her service to a new residence. She requested that the Commission direct the company to make certain management changes and that she be awarded monetary damages. On April 7, 2005, VarTec filed a letter signed by Complainant agreeing to a settlement amount of \$500.00. Complainant agreed to withdraw her complaint when she received the check. On April 14, 2005, Complainant filed a letter informing the Commission that she received a check in the amount of \$500.00. Complainant further stated that she wished to dismiss her complaint.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) states that a complainant may dismiss a complaint without an order of the Commission at any time before prepared testimony is filed or oral evidence offered. The parties have not filed prepared testimony or offered oral

evidence. This therefore serves notice that this complaint is dismissed and that this case may be closed.
